Based on the documentation provided by Maryland officials, correction of non-compliances associated with the State Complaints and providing of Free Appropriate Public Education (FAPE) to all children with disabilities in Maryland, without wasting valuable time and money of IEP team members, require development and implementation of an appropriate Behavioral Intervention Plan (BIP) for Ms. Marcella E. Communication protocol should include at least daily communication of proper code of conduct and disciplinary action procedures to Maryland staff fraudulently manipulating Maryland's records and data of children with disabilities, in programs receiving financial assistance from U.S. Department of Education.
